Dad Recounts Story of His Bride, Our Mom

Hospice Allows These Moments

Hospice of Orange & Sullivan Counties, Inc.'s Kaplan Family Hospice Residence was a "godsend" for our family. When my father entered the Kaplan Family Hospice Residence last summer, we experienced a level of dignity, respect, and caring previously missing from Dad's care. Once settled, Dad started to improve immediately from the excellent care and attention he was now receiving. My family and I got to enjoy special and meaningful moments with him we would not have otherwise experienced.

All the nurses knew his nickname (Mr. Big), frequently used it, and joked with him. They took the time to get to know our family and our family's stories. We decorated Dad's room with pictures and mementos. One day, after Dad had not eaten for quite some time, he woke up and wanted his favorite chocolate ice cream. We all watched joyfully as he enjoyed every drop of that delicious treat. After finishing his ice cream, Dad recounted a story about him and his beloved bride of 65 years, my mom! Hospice makes these special moments possible!

After my father passed, I thought I would be okay. However, shortly after returning home to Houston, I was diagnosed with breast cancer. My weekly chemo treatments prevented me from sharing the holidays with my family, which became challenging for me.

I knew I needed help, so I started individual grief counseling, virtually, with Hospice of Orange & Sullivan Counties Grief Bereavement Counselor, Kristin Palmieri, MA, LMHC, LPC. Although I did not know what to expect, I was open to all possibilities and getting help. The most surprising thing to me, was that the process was not sad, but rather, allowed me to honor and remember my most cherished memories of my father.

Kristin's questions were meaningful and focused. She would ask: "What did your father enjoy on Thanksgiving? What special memories do you have about your father and Christmas? What did you enjoy doing with your dad?" I loved these questions, and I loved sharing these stories about my Dad.

At first, our sessions were more of a "check-in" to see how I was doing. The nature of the questions evoked such loving and meaningful memories that over time I found I could share stories about my father. I found the grief counseling to be a very spiritual and honoring process. My experience with Hospice of Orange & Sullivan Counties and the Kaplan Family Hospice Residence was extraordinary, and I am grateful.
